Day 1

Find out what wildlife visits your garden by looking for animal tracks and droppings



Day 2

Put up a bird box to provide a safe place for garden birds to nest



Day 4

Put up butterfly feeders in your garden to help pollinator species



Day 5

Help create hedgehog highways by making a CD sized hole in the bottom of your garden



Day 6

Replace harmful garden pesticides with wildlife friendly alternatives
